## NOTICE OF RESIGNATION

Please accept this letter as formal notification of my intention to resign from my position as Chairman KCCA FC. In consideration of the current status of the club and licensing plans, I am happy to hold fort for the period until appointment of a substantive Chairperson.

Please note that since my appointment as the club Chairperson in October 2019 we have registered a number of achievements including;

- i. Increased the club administrative funding by 241%
- ii. Increased the club revenue collection by 33% despite the CoVID19 pandemic period and after effects
- iii. The club has reported profit for the last two financial years which is the first time in the club's available records.
- iv. Initiated the construction and secured funding of the KCCA FC stadium starting with the 6500 seater VIP wing currently under construction.
- v. Improved the club brand visibility through investment in media entertainment and evidenced by being the most followed Ugandan Club and among the top 55 at the African continent. We now have 275,805 followers across all platforms like YouTube
- vi. Introduced the KCCA FC TV during the COVID 19 pandemic and currently runs on NBS Sport
- vii. Won the Nkurunziza cup in Burundi and Cambiaso talent competition in Tanzania
- viii. Participated in CAF and CECAFA cup competitions
- ix. On boarded and strengthened many partners such as UPL, Chint Electric, MTN Uganda, Britam, Blink logistics, Star Times and others.
- x. Leveraged and on boarded Partners including Bet22, Blink Logistics, Mpaatanel, Century Cinema, Uganda Child Cancer Foundation among others.
- xi. Singed strategic partnerships with Yanga Sports Club, Teqball Federation Uganda (Sports equipment), Onetext pro (Gloves

Partner), Catapult (Player performance Gadgets), Mafro for training kits among others.

xii. Developed the KCCA Mobile App on the google play store to promote club content

xiii. Initiated the Wear Your Local Jersey Campaign to promote support for local clubs.

xiv. Installed night flood lights for promotion of night football.

xv. Promoted football talent to several countries including three players to Europe and two to the US league.

xvi. Finished Second on 3 occasions in four seasons well as the target was winning the championship.

In light of the above, I would like to express my appreciation to the Minister for Kampala, The Lord Mayor, the Kampala City Council and the Executive Director for granting me the opportunity to have worked in the position for the past four years.

I have learned a great deal during my time here and have enjoyed collaborating with the Government, the Club Patron, the Executive Sponsor (ED), the Board, the CEO KCCA FC and staff, the KCCA staff, the KCCA FC fans, FUFA, the Soccer Agents, Sports media family, the Sponsors and all stake holders. I will take a lot of what I have learned with me in my career and will look back at my time here as a valuable period of my professional life.

I will endeavor to make the transition as smooth as possible considering that we have a new technical department and players settling in, the team requires concentration in three competitions in August and September and completion of the Club strategy plan.

I will support in whatever way I can to hand over my duties to colleagues or to my replacement during the process.

I thank you for the tremendous support during my tenure and request for your continuous support for the club to excel locally and at the continent.
